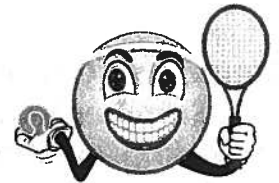

Ankle Biters:

Monday's 4:15 – 5:00 (45 min.)

The goal of this class is fun, fun, fun while learning & developing the basic strokes of the game. Using the USTA Quick Start format kids will play games and do drills that help emphasis basic movement and coordination skills that they will need in all sports. Tennis specific hand eye coordination drills will also be used to further our progress.

Smashers:

Monday's 5:00 – 6:00 (Hour)

The goal of these classes are to help children learn the basic skills to play the game as quickly as possible and to enjoy the experience of hitting balls over the net in a controlled rally situation. Skills will be taught using a combination of drills, games, and point play with the focus being on rallying and learning the basics to play points and learning to move efficiently on the court.

Junior Travel Tour:

Wednesday's 4:00 – 5:00 (Hour)

This class is designed for players who are further developing all tennis strokes with a combination of drills, games and point play. Basic rules, strategies, and on court conditioning will also be covered. There will be an emphasis on consistency and stroke development for competitive play. All levels welcome. Serving and Returning will be worked on in every class.

***Classes that do not meet the minimum requirement of students (4) will be shortened.**

***Payment must be made if full at/before the first class.**

***There will be a limit of "12" Students per Class on a first come first serve basis.**
